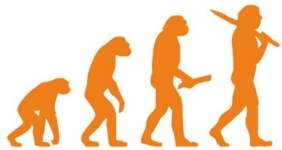

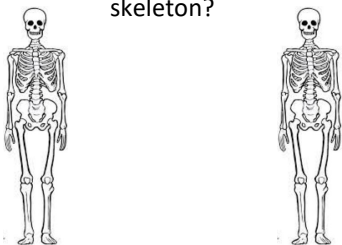

Can you draw a picture of what you think a caveman looked like. What is he wearing?



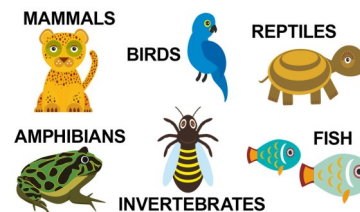
Can you find 3 interesting facts about the skeleton?
