History— to draw and write about their favourite toy. To compare old and new toys.



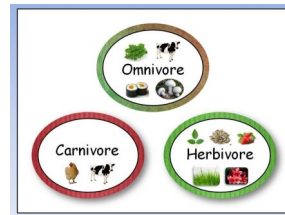
DT- Children to make their own moving toy or object.

English – Children to write a character description of a character from their favourite story. You could write about the characters from 'Lost and Found' or 'Traction Man'.



English— Children to practise writing simple sentences using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. Can you also practise writing capital letters. Write some sentences about your favourite animal.



Maths – Try subtracting and adding using numbers 0-20 or using objects.



Reading— Share a book with an adult. It could be fiction or non-fiction. Can you read a word / sentence / full story?
