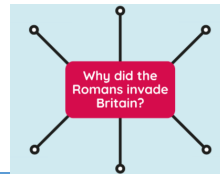

Why did the Romans first attempt to invade Britain? What natural resources did the Romans want?



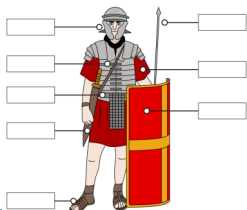
Can you find any interesting rocks in your garden or whilst out on a walk and take photos of them? Can you describe the texture?



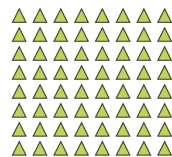
Have a look at the soil in your garden. What is it made out of? Make a list of what you find.
