Year 6 SATs Week

Monday 13th – Thursday 16th May 2024

As you will be aware, your child will be sitting their Year 6 Standard Assessment tests (SATs) this year. During the week beginning 13th May, children will complete tests in English and Maths. Please see the timetable below for the dates of the individual tests.

Monday 13 th May	English: EGPS Grammar, punctuation and spelling test	45 minute test for pupils to answer in a variety of ways followed by a 20 question spelling test.
Tuesday 14 th May	English: Reading	60 minute test containing 3 separate texts for pupils to read and answer questions on.
Wednesday 15 th May	Maths: Paper 1 Arithmetic Maths: Paper 2 Reasoning	30 minute arithmetic test 40 minute reasoning and problem solving paper
Thursday 16 th May	Maths: Paper 3 Reasoning	40 minute reasoning and problem solving paper

The tests will take place in the usual Year 6 teaching rooms and with staff the pupils are familiar with. There are some pupils who will have additional access arrangements but these will be discussed with you prior to the tests.

Tests are collected in and sent off to be officially marked offsite. Tests will be given the following scores: A raw score (the total number of marks achieved for each paper), a scaled score and a judgement of whether the National Standard has been met. All these scores will be communicated with you in July.

An example of the different tests will be available for you to view during the Parents Consultation meetings on Thursday 21st March. If you have any questions or if your child will receive different testing arrangements, your child's class teacher / Mrs Nixon will be very happy to discuss this with you at your appointment.
