


Welcome to Year 1

Dear Parent/Carer

We have put together lots of information about Year 1. It includes an overview of the learning that will take place this term, some key things to remember and some ideas for things to do at home to support learning in school.



Things to remember

As the weather gets colder, please remember to send your child in with appropriate clothing and footwear. We also ask that all coats and jumpers/cardigans have your child's name written in them.

Please make sure that reading books are brought back into school daily so they can be changed regularly. We have library and PE every Thursday. PE kits are provided but children are welcome to wear trainers for school on their PE day.

Homework tasks and fun activities

- Go for a walk around your local area. Record what you can see, hear and smell on your walk. See if you can draw a map of your route.
- Find a picture of you as a baby and think about how you have changed.
- Sing 'head, shoulders, knees and toes'
- Draw a picture of you and your friends
- Go outside and collect items to make an autumn treasure basket. Fill it with pine cones, sticks and leaves.

Learning in School	
English	We will be looking at a number of different fiction and non-fiction texts this term and we will be using them to create different types of writing. We will be looking at the story 'The Shopping Basket' and writing our own shopping lists and a character description.
	After half term we will be focusing on letter writing based on the story 'Cinderella' and then creating our own version of the story. Finally, we will be learning about poems, writing and performing one based on our senses.

Phonics	Phonics will continue to be taught daily in Year 1 with the children following the Read, Write
	inc scheme. The children will be learning a different sound each day and there will be lots of
	opportunities for the children to apply their learning when writing in the classroom, both in
	provision and when doing group work. The children will also be learning the Year 1 'tricky
	words' which we will be practising reading regularly throughout the school day.
Maths	The focus for this term will be consolidating the children's knowledge of place value and
	addition and subtraction within 20. The children will be using a range of practical resources
	to solve problems, compare quantities and numbers and develop reasoning skills to explain
	their answers. We will also be learning how to write and form numbers correctly to record
	our learning.
Science	To begin with we will be learning about the human body; labelling the different parts and
	learning about each of our senses. We will be doing lots of of practical activities to learn
	about which part of the body is associated with each sense. The children will then be
	learning about everyday materials and their properties; exploring if all materials are suitable
	for the same purpose and testing their ideas through a range of investigations and
	experiments.
PSHE	In PSHE we are starting the Story Project where this half term we will be focusing on
	friendship and reading the story 'The Friendship Bench'.
	After half term we will be reading the story 'The Big Family' and celebrating our own family.
	We will think about who is in our family and why they are special.
Art	The children will be focusing on painting skills. They will be taught how to represents ideas
	and how changing colour can change moods and feelings. They will learn how to mix colours
	and apply paint inspired by the artists Clarice Cliff and Jasper Johns.
Music	We will be exploring lots of different ways to keep the pulse. We will look at different styles
iviusic	of songs and practise finding the pulse. We will also experiment with different instruments.

Geography	Our focus for Geography this term is 'What is it like here?' To begin with the children will

	discuss what they see and visit in their local area. We will then be looking at simple maps of
	familiar areas for the children to follow and find clues. The children will then be creating a 3D
	model of our local area, using maps to ensure that landmarks have been placed correctly.
History	In History we will be learning about 'How am I making History?' We will be exploring our
	own histories and how we have changed over time. We will also explore special events and
	how these are remembered. This half term the children will create their own class memory
	box to look back on at the end of Year 1.
DT	The children will be making their own structures (windmills). They will be learning how to
	join materials together and how to strengthen a structure.
Computing	The children will be learning about what an algorithm is (precise instructions) and they will
	be producing their own algorithms and exploring what happens if they are given in the
	wrong order. We will then be learning how to enter and print text and save and retrieve
	work on a word processing programme.
PE	Our focus is gymnastics and dance this term. We will be looking at key shapes, developing
	balance, coordination and movement, travelling and balancing in different ways, using
	apparatus and the children will develop their own routines. After half term the children will
	be creating a dance based on the Lion King and exploring different movements.
RE	Our key question for the first half term will be 'Does God want Christians to look after the
	world? The children will be listening to the creation story and reflecting on how different
	people look after the world. We will then be learning about the Christmas story, thinking
	about what it means to give a gift and what would be a suitable gift for the baby Jesus.
